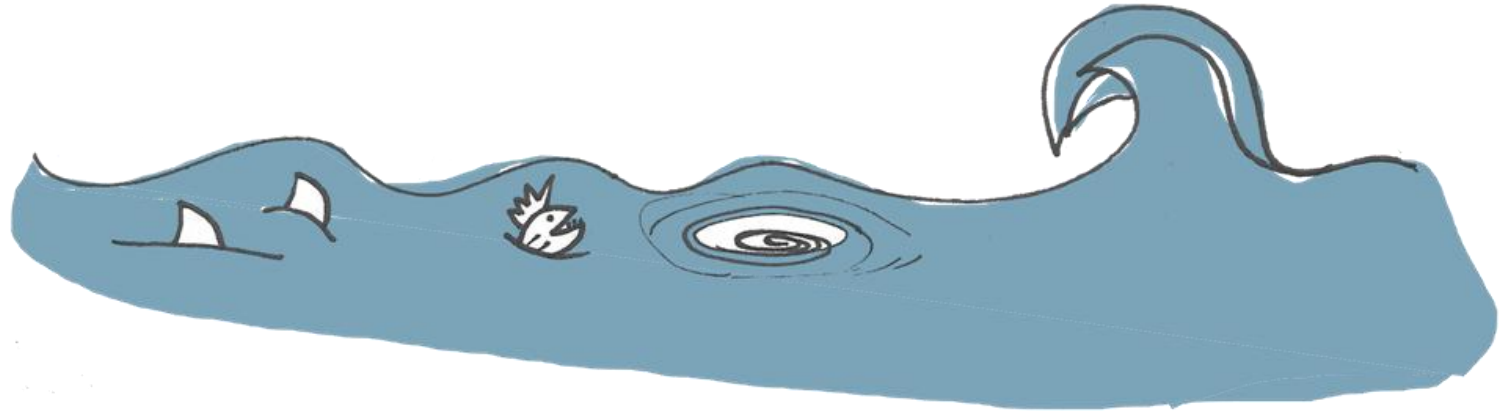
Plexus 2.0 is a professional **network community** that *addresses real-world challenges through the understanding, advancement and diffusion of ideas and practices rooted in complexity theory.*

Our Self-organizing Language

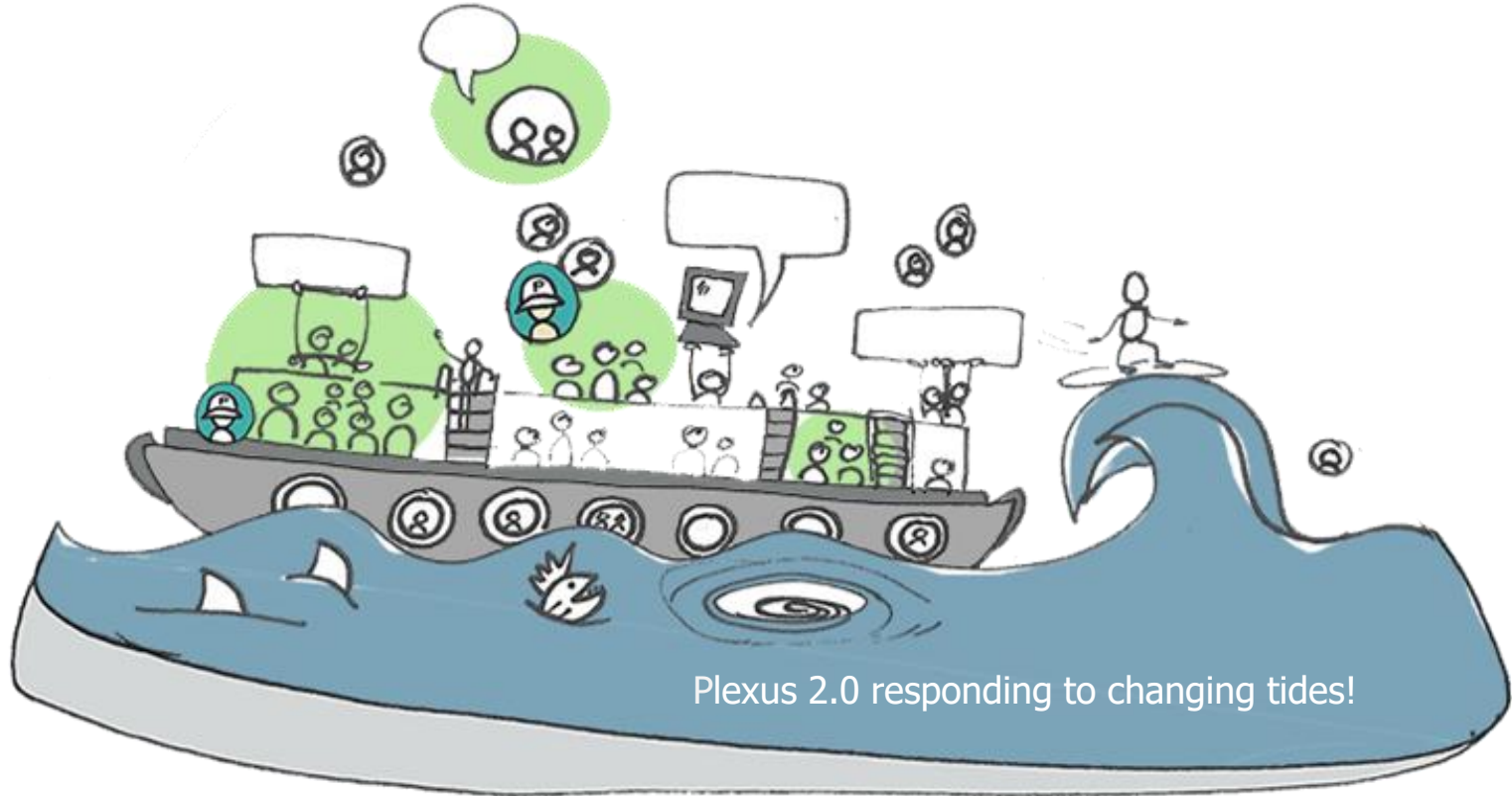


-
- Catalysts** = self-organizing leaders who initiate, influence and coordinate the key clusters and emerging projects in the network
- Clusters** = a term for sets of people interested in a specific activity, issue or topic who self-organize to act or learn
- Projects** = people gather to engage, practice and work on network driven opportunities and areas of interest, also called a 'project cluster'
- Circles** = formed to work on specific network operations, activities or projects (circles can form within a cluster and become a project cluster themselves)
- Pop-ups** = a one time session to learn or discuss a particular topic (can be a form of a cluster)

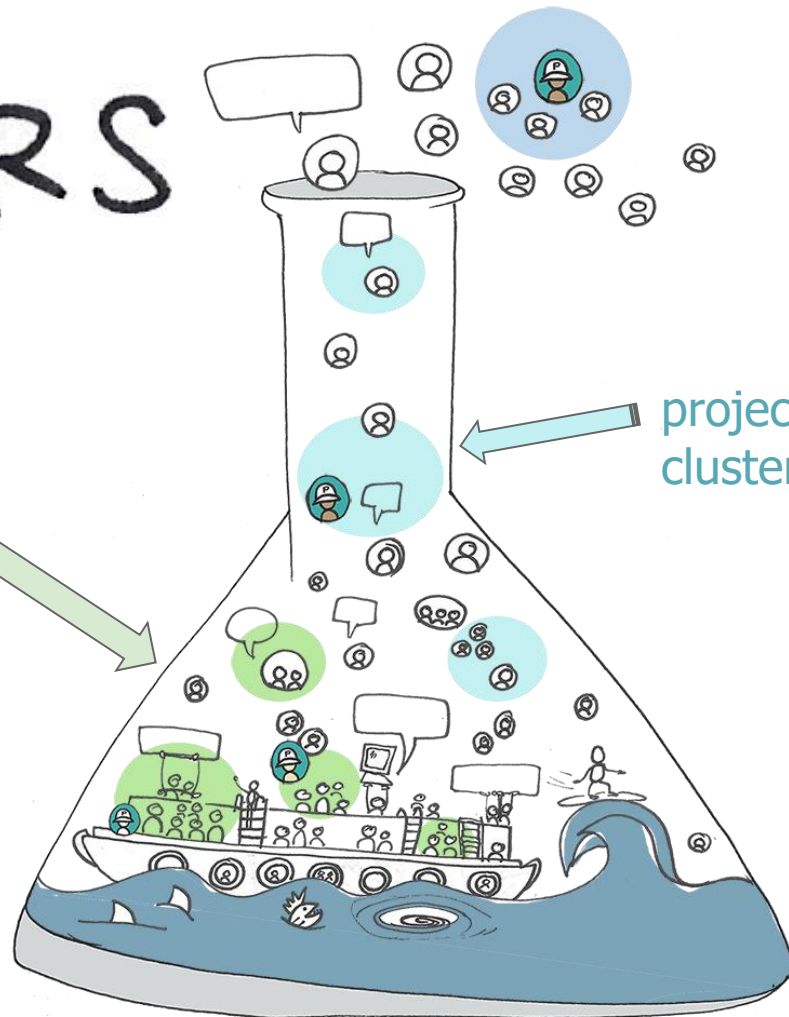

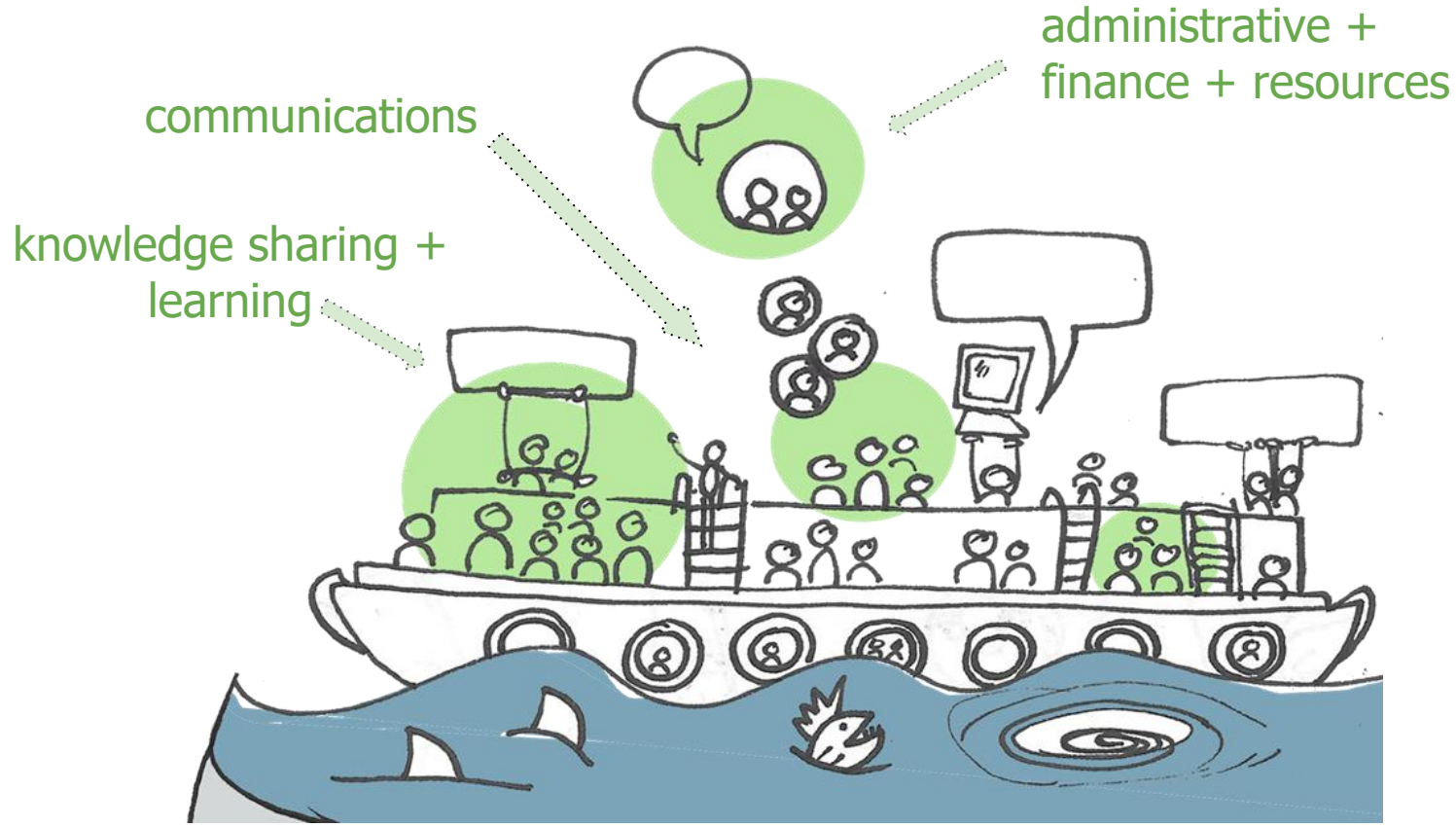

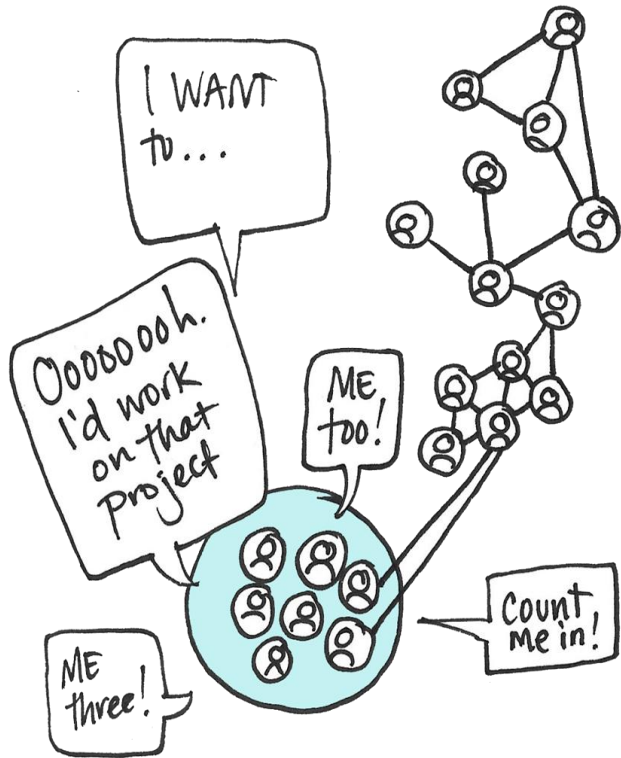


NETWORK CLUSTERS



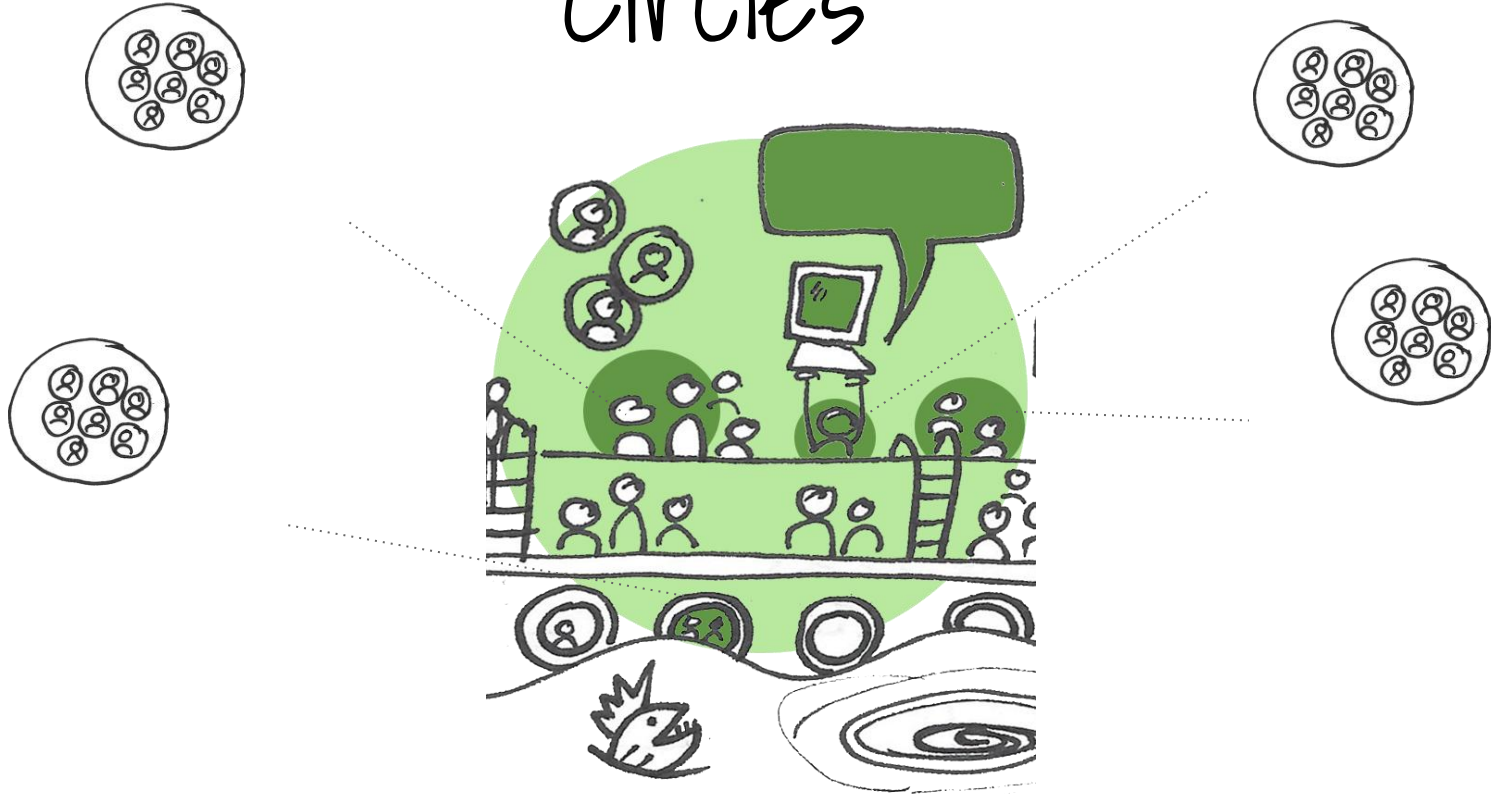

Circles



Formed to work on specific network operations, activities or projects
(circles often form within a cluster)

Communications Cluster...with activities



There may be many smaller specific circles within a cluster

POP-UPS



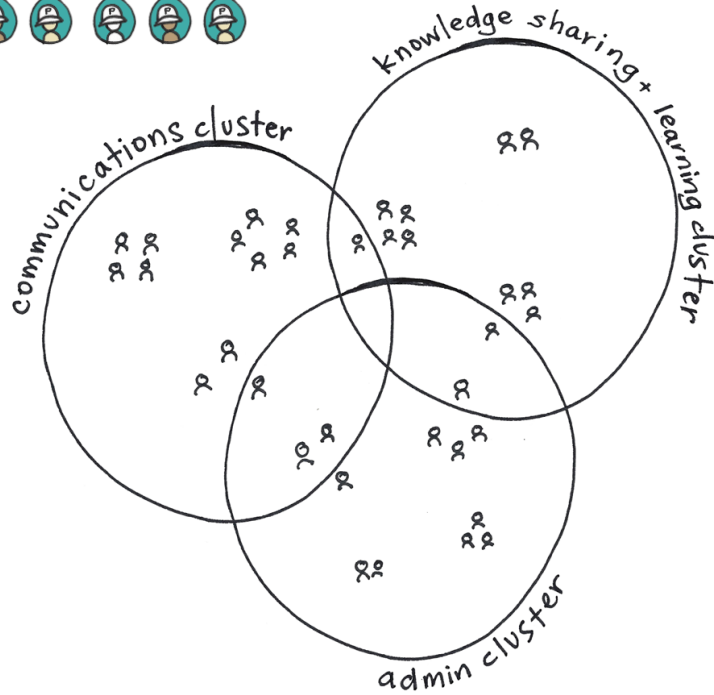
A one time session to share, learn or discuss a particular topic
